

Supplies



Fireline 6lb Needle 10/0 Clasp with jump or split rings

General

Each bead has its own color. It ranges from dark to light. If the same type of beads in different colors are used, these are also marked with different colors in the drawings. New added beads are darker than already existing beads in the piece.

Generally in my instructions the diagrams come first. The texts are additions to the pictures. The diagrams show the thread path. The letters identifying the individual beads are given in the order in which the beads are used for the first time.

This guide is designed to be printed as a booklet.

General to the bracelet


The individual strands of the bracelet are beaded in RAW (Right Angle Weave) with two needles. The strands are connected with RAW with one needle.

The description in the instructions are for a 19 cm (7.5'') bracelet. The length can be changed by the number of pattern units. A pattern unit is 1 cm (0.4'') long.

Long Strand


Two long strands are needed.

Thread a needle on both ends of a 2 m (6.6') thread. Pick up one GemDuo (A) and five 2 mm FirePolish (B). The top of the GemDuo shows up. Slide the beads into the middle of the thread. Bead again through the A and thus close the ring.







Pick up two B on both threads and cross through the second hole of A.




Pick up three B on one thread, three B and one A on the other. Pass through A with the thread without A.




Repeat steps 2 and 3 twelve times. Repeat step 2 one more time. Pick up three B on one thread, two B on the other. Pass with the second thread through the third B. Sew the red marked thread in.



One short strand is needed. Thread a needle on both ends of a 2 m (6.6') thread. Pick up 4 B and close the ring through the first B. Slide the ring into the middle of the thread. Pick up two B on one thread, two B and one A on the other. Pass through A with the thread without A.



Repeat steps 2 and 3 twelve times. Repeat step 2 one more time. Pick up three B on one thread, two B on the other. Pass with the second thread through the third B. Pick up two B on one thread, one B on the other. Pass through the second B. Sew the threads in.



The two long strands are laid on the outside and the short in the middle. There is one working thread at each end of the bracelet.





Pass through two B. Pick up four B and pass through the two B again. Pass through the first three new B.

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Pick up four B and pass through the two B. Pass through the first three new B.




Pass through the top bead of the short strand. Pick up three B and pass through the two starting beads. Pass through the next three B.

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Repeat step 9. Pick up one B and pass through the two B on the side of the second long strand. Pick up one B and pass through the two staring beads. Pass through the next three B. Pass through the group three B, A, two B, A, five B.







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Add a B between each B on the outer edge. At the end of the row pass through two B, one A, two B, one A and four B.

Pass through six B. Pick up seven 11/0 Seed Beads (C). Pass through the second C and close the ring. Pass through the C in the ring again. Pick up one C and pass through the last six B on the outer edge. Pass through the group two B, one A, two B, one A and four B. Repeat the thread path from step 12 and 13 then sew the thread in.

Repeat the steps 8 to 13 on the other edge of the bracelet. The clap is attached to the eyelets with jump or split rings
